Aug 26<sup>th</sup> 99°F tied the old record set in 1975

Oct 19<sup>th</sup> 87°F tied the old record set in 1938

Nov 03<sup>rd</sup> 83°F tied the old record set in 1974

### Record Low Minimums: 2

Apr 06<sup>th</sup> 27°F tied the old record set in 1975

May 16<sup>th</sup> 39°F tied the old record set in 1920, 1984



### Record High Minimums: 3

Aug 13<sup>th</sup> 78°F new record the old record was 77°F in 1995.

Aug 14<sup>th</sup> 77°F new record the old record was 76°F in 1943.

Aug 17<sup>th</sup> 76°F tied the old record set in 2010 and 1997.



### Record High Daily Mean: 4

Apr 01<sup>st</sup> 71.5°F tied the old record set in 1979

Aug 13<sup>th</sup> 87.0°F new record the old record was 86.5°F in 1926.

Aug 14<sup>th</sup> 88.0°F tied the old record set in 1943

Aug 26<sup>th</sup> 85.5°F tied the old record set in 1975 and 1900
