Note. all the thermometrical observations of the year 1798. & those of 1799. to June 17. inclusive are to be rejected. During that period my thermometer had been placed in the N. E. portico, newly built, and it was not till June 17. 99. that I discovered it to be artificially heated, probably by the mound of earth in it. I then removed the 2 thermometers to approved positions.

This is a note by Jefferson that he realized the temperatures from 1798 to 1799 were not accurate because of the placement of his thermometers.
