STORM	HAZE	4 Thunderstorms this month A noon on the 6th it was thundering to the north and turned SE toward Grindstone Mt. but then turned again in about 30 minutes and headed in our direction. We had much lightning and 1.06 inches of rain but little wind. August 19th Hurricane Cleo passed by VA and was about 500 miles east of the coast. Aug. 30th at 7:20 to 8:30PM we had a Thunderstorm that came from the SW and gave 1.21 inches of rain.
