Mar-01	MY SON SAW A LIGHTNING FLASH LAST NIGHT DURING THE SNOW AROUND 9 PM, HOWEVER, I DID NOT OBSERVE ANY HERE-LIGHT DRIZZLE DURING NIGHT GAVE A THIN
Mar-02	SNOW PELLETS DURING EARLY MORNING HOURS LASTED BETWEEN ONE AND TWO HOURS-RICHMOND NATIONAL AIRPORT REC. 6.3 INS. OF SNOW BUT MORE SNOW
Mar-03	THE SECOND COLDEST DAY OF THE WINTER AND COLDEST SINCE JAN. 17, 2009- ALSO RICHMOND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT REPORTED A LOW OF 11 °F WHICH TIED THE
Mar-04	RICHMOND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT HAD A MIN. OF 10 °F THIS MORNING WHICH SET A NEW REC. LOW FOR DATE AND NEW ALL TIME REC. FOR MONTH OF MARCH
Mar-05	MUCH WARMER TODAY AND A LOT OF THE SNOW MELTED
Mar-06	ALTOCUMULUS CLEARED AT 1430
Mar-07	MOSTLY CLOUDY IN AM AND PM WAS PARTLY CLOUDY WITH A GREAT DEAL OF SUN PASSING THROUGH THE SCATTERED CIRRUS OF PM-WARMEST SINCE 10/16/2007
Mar-08	SUN THROUGH CIRRUS BUT MOST OF SKY COVERED-82 °F TODAY AND ONE WEEK AGO THE MAX. WAS 32 °F-WARMEST DAY SINCE 10/16/2007 WHEN IT WAS 88 °F
Mar-09	VERY LOW RE. HUMIDITY AND A BREEZY DAY-AM VERY CLEAR AND PM CIRRUS CAME IN AT 1300 AND LASTED THROUGH SUNSET
Mar-10	MOSTLY CLOUDY ALL DAY AND MUCH COOLER
Mar-11	CLEARING STARTED AT 1250 WITH VARIABLE PM CLOUDINESS BUT MOSTLY PARTLY CLOUDY
Mar-12	VERY LOW REL. HUMIDITY TODAY ASSOC. WITH CLOUDY WEATHER (UNUSUAL)
Mar-13	ONLY A LITTLE SLEET ALMOST ALL SNOW BUT TOO WARM AND MUCH OF THE SNOW MELTED AS IT FELL
Mar-14	STEADY RAIN FROM 1100-2000-RAIN WAS NEEDED AFTER A LONG DRY PD. -MAX. PRECIP. RATE PER HOUR WAS 0.063 AT 1420-3RD PD. OF PRECIP. 0830-2010, 4TH PD. 2305-2400
Mar-15	LIGHT AM FOG -ANOTHER DAY OF ALMOST CONTINUOUS LIGHT RAIN
Mar-16	LIGHT AM FOG - DAMP DAY BUT A LITTLE WARMER EACH OF LAST 3 DAYS
Mar-17	VERY LIGHT AM FOG
Mar-18	HEAVY AM FOG REACHING MAX. DENSITY AT 0750 BUT CLEARED AT 0930 AND BECAME FIRST CLEAR DAY IN A WEEK
Mar-19	MOSTLY CLEAR EARLY AM AND PARTLY CLOUDY LATE AM BECOMING CLOUDY FROM NOON TO SUNSET
Mar-20	CLEAR AFTER 0830-NOON AND A FEW SCATTERED CLOUDS FROM 1310-1520
Mar-21	FIRST CIRRUS CLOUDS AT 1300 THAT BECAME ALTOCUMULUS BY 1800 AND PM WAS ALMOST CLOUDY-EST. CLOUD COVER 65%
Mar-22	ONLY A FEW CLOUDS AFTER 1700
Mar-23	DRY COLD FRONTAL PASSAGE AT 0430-FEW CIRRUS AFTER 1450 BUT CLEAR AGAIN AFTER 1515
Mar-24	CLEAR TO NOON AND PARTLY CLOUDY WITH CIRRUS FROM 1200-1600 THEN CLOUDY WITH CIRRUS TO SUNSET
Mar-25	VERY LIGHT ON AND OFF SPRINKLES BET. 1815-2050-VERY LOW DEW POINT TEMPS. AND LOW REL. HUMIDITY FOR AN EVENING WITH PRECIP. OCCURRING IN MARCH
Mar-26	3RD PD. OF PRECIP. 1100-1920 LIGHT AM FOG-MAX. PRECIP. RATE PER HR. WAS 0.15 INS. AT 1824
Mar-27	HEAVY AM FOG AND THE HEAVIEST AT 0720 WITH VISIBILITY A LITTLE LESS THAN 0.2 MILES
Mar-28	HEAVIEST RAIN OCCURRED AT 0028 AT A RATE OF 1.50 INS. PER HR.- 3RD PD. OF PRECIP. 2020-2050, 4TH PD. 2220-2355
Mar-29	BAROMETER REACHED A MIN. PRESSURE OF 29.30 FROM A DEEP LOW PRESSURE THAT PASSED TO OUR NW AND GAVE WIND GUSTS TO 39 MPH
Mar-30	CIRRUS CLOUDS STARTED COMING IN AT 1100 AND CLOUDY FROM 1100 to 1340 THEN PARTLY CLOUDY TO 1750 BUT CLEAR UNTIL SUNSET
Mar-31	MODERATE DEW AND SOME OF THE DEW WAS FROZEN ON COOLER SURFACES-CI CAME IN AT 1100 & CLOUDY WITH CIRRUS AFTER 1520
