| Jul-10 | VERY MUGGY PM WITH RAIN MAINLY IN AFTERNOON |

| Jul-12 | VACATION 8-14-DEWS NOT RECORDED DURING THIS PERIOD |
| Jul-13 | VERY DRY PERIOD WITH GREAT HEAT |
| Jul-14 | 3RD PD. OF PRECIP. 0545-0625, 4TH PD. 0755-0800, 5TH PD. 1145-1320, 6TH PD. 1640-1805 THUNDERSTORM, 7TH PD. 1915-1935, 8TH PD. 2250-2300 |
| Jul-15 | NOT MUCH OF A STORM BUT A LONG PERIOD OF LIGHTNING BUT NO STRIKES CLOSE TO STATION- 3RD PD. OF PRECIP. 1715-1720 SPRINKLE, 4TH PD. |
| Jul-16 | HOT AND VERY HUMID, MAX. DEW POINT WAS 74.9 °F |
| Jul-17 | NEW MAX. TEMP. REC. FOR THE DATE AT GLEN ALLEN-OLD REC. WAS 96 °F IN 2010 |
| Jul-18 | NEW MAX. TEMP. REC. FOR THE DATE AT GLEN ALLEN-OLD REC. WAS 98°F IN 2010-SOME CLOUDS AFTER 1730-A SLOW MOVING SMALL STORM |
| Jul-19 | STILL VERY HOT |
| Jul-20 | NOT AS HOT BUT VERY HUMID-MAX. DEW POINT OF 75.9 °F AT 1415-STRONG THUNDERSTORM PASSED TO SOUTH THIS EVENING |
| Jul-21 | 3RD PD. OF PRECIP. 1325-1335, 4TH PD. 1525-1700, HEAVIEST PD. OF RAIN FOR DAY, 5TH PD. 1910-1940, DRIZZLE, 6TH PD. 2110-2300 DRIZZLE |
| Jul-22 | DRIZZLE IN EARLY AM-CLOUDY ALL DAY EXCEPT A BIT OF SUN FROM 1600-1845 |
| Jul-23 | HEAVY DEW AND VERY HUMID MUGGY DAY-MAX. DEW POINT WAS 77.2 °F AT 1022 |
| Jul-24 | ANOTHER VERY HUMID AND MUGGY DAY WITH A HIGHER MAX. TEMP. OF 96 °F AND MAX. DEW POINT WAS 78.5 °F AT 1332 |
| Jul-25 | COOL DAY FOR THIS JULY THAT HAS BEEN SO HOT |
| Jul-26 | AM PARTLY CLOUDY WITH A FEW THIN CIRRUS BUT VERY HOT DAY AND HUMID WITH MAX. DEW POINT OF 78.1 °F AT 1151 |
| Jul-27 | SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS WITH MOST OF STRONGER STORMS TO SOUTH-STILL HUMID WITH MAX DEW POINT OF 74.4 °F AT 1108 |
| Jul-28 | MAX. DEW POINT OF 75.5 °F VERY HUMID AGAIN TODAY |
| Jul-29 | PM ABOUT 20% CLOUDY - A LITTLE COOLER TODAY AND ALSO LESS HUMID |
| Jul-30 | THUNDER AT 1432, 1448 AND 1505 - LUCKY TO GET RAIN FROM A SMALL SLOW MOVING TS CELL. |
