3. Light, misty rain late in the forenoon.

4. Thunder-storm and a few drops of rain in the afternoon.

5. Thunder, with a little rain, late in the afternoon and early night.

6. Thunder, with a little rain, early at night.

7. Light thunder and rain about noon.

8. Light thunder and rain early at night.

9. High wind, thunder-storm, and rain in the afternoon.

10. Shower in the forenoon.

11. Light showers late in the afternoon.

12. Light showers late in the afternoon.

13. A few drops of rain in the afternoon.

Rainfall for the month, 2.11 inches.

Observations taken each morning at 7 o'clock.

During the month there were 10 clear days, 8 partly cloudy, and 12 in which the sky was entirely obscured by clouds at the time of observation.

During the month there were 10 clear days, 8 partly cloudy, and 12 in which the sky was entirely obscured by clouds at the time of observation.

It will be observed the mean temperature was higher, with the exception of 1895 (when it was the same as this year), than in any similar month for the past eighteen years.

There has been very little rain—only 2.11 inches—much below the average for the period over which our record extends. Rain is greatly needed for vegetation in this vicinity, and growing crops are suffering for want of it.
