April 5 th	93 °F	old record 89 °F in 1942

The high of 105 °F and low of 79 °F on the 24th & 25th yields a daily average temp of 92.0 °F which breaks the all-time daily mean temp of 91.5. Thus these are the hottest two days ever recorded in the past 113 years for the month of July or for any month. Lastly Richmond has not hit 105 °F since July 6 1977 when it was also 105 °F.

On May 2, 2010 the minimum temperature was 72 °F.

This is a new 113 year record for earliest occurrence of a minimum temperature of 70 °F degrees or higher. The old record was 70 °F set on May 11, 1916.
